PROGRAM AIM

The Greater Derry Juvenile Diversion program empowers youth to make responsible decisions by offering an alternative to court intervention while holding them accountable for their actions. During the intake interview process, information is gathered to assess all aspects of the youth and his/her family. Consequently, we are able to create accountability contracts that not only repair the harm caused by the alleged offense, but that also addresses other risky behavior and/or issues that may contribute to the youth's poor decision making.
