The Office of Youth Services provides programs and services aimed at preventing juvenile delinquency, reducing court involvement and empowering youth. The Office of Youth Services is committed to advocating for youth and seeks to improve the quality of life of children and youth at risk in Hillsborough and Cheshire County. Programs and services emphasize accountability, education, self-advocacy, self-esteem, development and decision-making skills in a positive, non-judgmental and confidential atmosphere.

The goal of our Diversion program is to hold young people accountable and educate them to make better decisions. We utilize Restorative Justice principles and help youth make positive connections with their community. The majority of our community service is supervised, community based, and involves groups of young people on weekly basis. Juvenile Diversion accountability contracts are unique and focus on the strengths and needs of the participant.
