PROGRAM ST	diversion cases pre-court for referral into the program based upon the criteria of first offense, under the age of 18, youth are willing to take full responsibility, and do not contest police report. It is a community-based alternative to the formal court process that integrates restorative justice practices, promotes positive youth development and reduces juvenile crime and recidivism. Rochester Juvenile Diversion has been serving Rochester youth since 1980, one of the oldest and completely independently funded programs in NH. Rochester Juvenile Diversion also runs a separate Teen Drug Court, one of the only programs in the State that utilizes peer influence to administer restorative justice. Rochester Juvenile Diversion has been acknowledged in having one of the most successful collaborations in the State, through developing the Rochester Teen Night, serving over 330 youth through the school year as prevention and intervention tool for juvenile delinquency.
