PROGRAM AIM	<p>The Seacoast Community Diversion Program (SCDP) provides a 12-week program for first-time youth offenders that is supportive and holds participants accountable for their actions. Individual contracts created for all youth incorporate restorative justice principles such as community service, apology letters, and/or educational components, like applicable online courses. The SCDP also offers support by encouraging individual or group-based therapy for participants; requiring weekly individual meetings between the participant and program director to go over contract obligations as well as to work on beneficial skills for the youth; and requiring parents to attend the community parent group for guardians of challenging teens, funded by the SCDP. The overall goal of the SCDP is to aid youth in making reparations for their actions, understanding their mistakes, and learning how to divert behaviors in a supportive environment.</p>
