PROGRAM AIM	<p>CADY, Inc. works with schools and communities to prevent and reduce youth alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use. Desired outcomes for youth include the formation of healthy attitudes, empathy for harmed party/parties, responsibility for personal actions, respect for self and others, and personal connections to the community that promotes a lasting change in behavior.</p> <p>Restorative Justice is a response to juvenile crime that emphasizes repairing the harm that was created by the offense. The restorative practice includes a panel process that promotes dialogue between the stakeholders to discuss consequences of the crime, harm to the harmed party/parties, and to direct needed action by the offender. Instead of asking: "What law was broken?" or "Who broke the law?" Restorative Justice asks: "Who was harmed?" and "Who is responsible for repairing the harm?"</p>
