PROGRAM AIM	<p>We offer best-practice programs to 100-150 Manchester children and teens each year, and strive to strengthen families, improve risky decisions and reduce involvement with the juvenile justice system. Our mission is to build strong families-free from abuse, addiction, and court involvement.</p> <p>This early intervention program gives youth an opportunity to earn a second chance while being held accountable, ensures parent involvement through participation in a family assessment and follow-up, addresses underlying issues that may have led to the arrest, such as substance use, anger management and school difficulties, enables Courts to focus on youth seriously in need of court intervention.</p> <p>We engage the community through a volunteer committee comprised of area teens and adults, which designs creative contracts of consequences for each youth, addressing the illegal behaviors as well as any other challenges taking place in the family.</p>
