Restorative Justice Practices | Promote Positive Youth Development Reduce Juvenile Crime and Recidivism

New Hampshire is home to 18+ Accredited Juvenile Court Diversion Programs that hold youth accountable for disruptive behavior while ensuring they benefit from education and support services to improve their behavior and not end up in juvenile court. The purpose of the Network is to:

- Promote principles of Restorative Justice
- Advocate for each member program and support the communitybased individuality of each
- Utilize evidence based programming and best practices
- Promote principles of Restorative Justice in shaping juvenile law and policy in NH
- Promote the use of common data across diversion programs to substantiate outcomes
- To aid in maintaining high educational standards by sponsoring joint trainings and seminars

The NH Juvenile Court Diversion Network was formed in the 1980's by a group of professionals seeking to create more effective ways to assist low-risk juvenile offenders who didn't belong in court. Governed by a dedicated group of volunteers, Network members share ideas and knowledge, help programs meet accreditation standards, and work with communities to develop new diversion resources.
